Enclosed document 2. Rules and Details

1. Objectives

1.1 To promote biodiversity of marine lives at the sites of H.T.M.S. Prab and H.T.M.S. Sattakut to tourists

1.2 To promote the H.T.M.S. Underwater Learning Site among tourists and to support tourist activities in the area

1.3 To invite divers and the general public to experience and understand the beauty and value of the H.T.M.S. Underwater Learning Site: H.T.M.S. Prab & Sattakut through a photo contest

1.4 To present the photos from the contest in an exhibition about the H.T.M.S. Underwater Learning Site that aims to encourage conservation of natural resources and marine environment

2. There are 2 photo categories

2.1 H.T.M.S. Prab and/or H.T.M.S. Sattakut

2.2 Biodiversity in H.T.M.S. Prab and/or H.T.M.S. Sattakut

3. Judging Criteria

3.1 Aesthetic quality and composition according to visual art principles

3.2 Communication of ideas and meanings under the theme “H.T.M.S. Underwater Learning Site: H.T.M.S. Prab & Sattakut”

3.3 For the category of biodiversity in H.T.M.S. Prab and/or H.T.M.S. Sattakut, the photo must clearly depict elements and characteristics of the marine lives at the sites of H.T.M.S. Prab and/or H.T.M.S. Sattakut.

3.4 Level of difficulty and photography technique

3.5 Popular Vote Award will be judged on the number of Likes on Facebook: PTTEP Photo Contest during 7-19 November 2017



4. Participant Details

4.1 Participant must hold the rights to ownership of the entry photos which they have photographed by themselves.

4.2 Participant can submit to all categories but are limited to 5 entries per category (5 photographs of H.T.M.S. Prab and/or H.T.M.S. Sattakut / 5 photographs of biodiversity in H.T.M.S. Prab and/or H.T.M.S. Sattakut).

4.3 Participant can win only one being of the highest value prize.

4.4 Participant must not violate the regulations of the Department of Marine and Coastal Resources and the Department of Fisheries, as well as any laws concerning natural resources and marine environment.

4.5 Participant must not decorate, transform or alter the natural environment in such manner to take the photos. The judges reserve the right to immediately cancel or revoke the prize awarded to the entrant who violates this rule and/or ask for all the prizes to be returned and disqualify the entrant from the contest. The judges' decision is final.

4.6 There is no entry fee.

4.7 Officials and employees of the organizations involved in the contest and employees of PTT Group may not participate in the contest.

5. Details of Entry Photos

5.1 Photos must be taken during the period of 1 November 2011 - 15 October 2017.

5.2 Photos must be in digital format.

5.3 Original files must be in high resolution suitable for enlarged printing. The shortest dimension must be at least 2,500 pixels with a resolution of at least 300 dpi. It must not bear watermarks, credits, texts or graphics.

5.4 Files for submission must be at least 1,280 pixels at the shortest dimension, with a resolution of at least 72 dpi. It must not bear watermarks, credits, texts or graphics.

5.5 Submitted file must be in .JPEG format.

5.6 Award winners must submit the original, unaltered version of their photos to the judges for verification.



5.7 Photos that have won prizes in other contests, both locally and internationally, and those that have been published in print and digital media are not eligible for entry. In all cases, if the photo is proven to fail this condition after winners are announced, the entrant will lose the right to claim a prize and the prize will be recalled. This rule does not apply to photos that have been posted on social media for non-commercial purposes.

5.8 Entry photos must not have a binding condition on copyrights with any organization, and it must not be available as stock photos. The organizer shall not be responsible for any violation of copyrights that the entrant may have agreed in a binding contract with any individual or organization. The entrant shall be responsible for such case.

5.9 Both colour and black-and-white photos are eligible, but they must be from a single file. Colour adjustment and technical alteration to improve the photo quality is permitted. Sediments and bubbles can be erased, but alterations of other objects are not allowed. The final product must look natural and not deviated from reality. The judges' discretion is final.

5.10 Submitted photos must be accompanied by a completed application form.

5.11 Any entry photo that fails to meet any of the above conditions will be disqualified. If a photo has been awarded but later was claimed to have violated a rule, if the claim could be proven valid the organizer could revoke and change the judges' decision as well as asking for all prizes to be returned without the organizer being liable for the actions.

5.12 The "Popular Vote" and the "Finalist" winners (20 photos per category) grant PTT Exploration and Production Plc., or PTTEP, the right to use the Photo Images submitted to the Contest for any means, including the display and/or publication of the photos in media for marketing and PR purpose. In doing so, PTTEP shall credit the photographers with full names at the bottom of each photo. In agreement to such terms and conditions, the winner shall sign a Copyright Ownership and License Agreement with PTTEP with compensation of 3,000 THB per Photo Image (Remark: the signing of agreement will take place at the awarding ceremony on 24 November 2017 at PTTEP Headquarter, for those winners unable to attend in person a Copyright Ownership and License Agreement can be signed and posted to PTTEP in advance)

5.13 The "Popular Vote" and the "Finalist" winners photos will be published in the contest photo book. The organizer will deliver 3 books to each winner together with the certificate.



5.14 The judges' decisions are final and not appealable.

5.15 The organizer reserves the right to change the conditions and rules of the contest as it deems appropriate.

5.16 In the cases where a third party makes use of the entry photo without PTTEP's consent, PTTEP and the PTT Group are not liable for damages which might occur as a result of such uses.

5.17 By submitting an entry, the entrant agrees to follow the above rules.
